

4th International Danube Day Győr, 29-30 of June 2007



On 29th of June 2007 the 4th Danube Day will be celebrated in the catchment of the Danube. 17 countries organize programs to raise awareness about the Danube, about the cultural, ecological and natural role of the second biggest river in Europe.

The Keret Association and the North-Transdanubian Environment Protection and Water Management Directorate organized the programs with many partners on the bank of the Mosoni-Danube in Győr. The main aim of this team is to create a traditional event in the region involving numerous international partners. The program is focusing to show modern cultural values due to a new perspective of environment-friendly thinking.

Every year we organize an open-air VJ-DJ event with an exhibition to introduce the values of the Danube with the help of the multimedia. Our idea is to realize an international VJ and DJ festival to show how many perspectives there are to think about the environment and the Danube. It will be a thematic competition, performances (films with music) will be awarded by a jury.
